What is this Huge Clock thing?

Huge Clock is a very large digital clock screensaver. The black background covers everything including the task bar on the bottom. It has no frame so there are no borders. It shows the time, date, and day of the week. That is all it does. Just a clock. But it is a huge clock man. To exit the program just press any key, click the mouse, or move the mouse. It installs both as a normal program and a real screensaver with password ability and preview in the small Windows screensaver setup screen. The display can be customized to show the time only, AM/PM, or 24-hour time. The display fonts, font size, and colors can also be changed. The day, date, and seconds display can be turned on or off.

My other name for this program is "The Thousand Dollar Clock" because it turns your expensive computer into a cheap clock.

This is a 32-bit program and will run on Windows XP, NT, 2000, ME, Vista, Windows 7, 8, 10, and Windows 11. It also runs OK on 64-bit systems.

Setup

When the program is running, press the C key and this setup screen pops up:



The changes you make on this screen are shown in the preview panel on the left. Press the "OK" button and the changes will be saved and used the next time the program runs. Press the "Cancel" button and the changes will not be saved. The help button displays this help file.

Each of the 3 lines can be customized. The top line is usually the day of the week, but it can be changed to the date, or made invisible. The middle line (time) can be set to show just the time in 12-hour or 24-hour format. Check the "Show Seconds" check box below the preview panel and the seconds are added to the time display. The bottom line is usually the date, but it can be changed to the day of the week, or made invisible.

Check the "Escape to Close" check box and you must press the Escape Key to close and exit the program. Does not close on any other key or mouse action.

On each line you can select a different font and font color in the drop-down boxes. Or press the "More Colors" button to select a custom color. If you check the boxes the font can be made bold or italic. The font size can be changed using the spin edit on the right. The program automatically sets a large font size. Be careful to not set the font size too large. For example, if you set the size when the time is 5:00 be sure there is enough room to display another digit when time is 12:00.

Keyboard Commands

When the program is running you can press any one of these keys.

F1 = Shows this help file.

H =Shows this help file.

A = Shows program About information screen

C = Configure program

Install

As an Administrator run the program <u>hugeclock-setup.exe</u> to install the program. This will copy all the files to the

Windows System Folder:

C:\Windows\System32 (on 32-bit Windows)
C:\Windows\SysWOW64 (on 64-bit Windows)

Programs with an .scr extension in these folders, such as hugeclock.scr, are recognized by Windows as screensavers and appear in the Windows list of available screensavers. A desktop shortcut link to hugeclock.scr is also created so you can run hugeclock as a normal program. Hugeclock is a 32-bit program but also runs fine on 64-bit systems.

The install program will overwrite any previous version so you are not required to uninstall older versions.


An alternate install method is to download the executable screensaver file <u>hugeclock.scr</u> and manually copy it to the Windows System Folder shown above.

A screensaver is actually a real program, but the file extension is .scr instead of the usual .exe found on most program files. This allows Windows to recognize the program as a screensaver when it is placed in the Windows System Folder.

To setup Huge Clock as your screensaver on Windows 10:

Right-click on the Desktop. Personalize. Lock screen. Screen saver settings.

and then this screen is shown:



Then use the "Screen Saver" drop-down box and pick "hugeclock" from the list of screen savers. Then click OK. The "Settings" button brings up the setup screen above. The "Preview" button runs the screensaver in full screen mode.

Earlier versions of Windows may have slightly different steps.

You can also change the settings by pressing the C key when the screensaver is running.

UnInstall

Open Windows Control Panel, select Programs and Features, select the program in the list of programs, and click the uninstall button, or right click on the program and select Uninstall in the menu. The Windows uninstall system will then run and remove the program. If you installed the program manually then delete the files to uninstall the program, and also delete any Desktop shortcut links

Then delete this entire key in the Windows Registry:

HKEY CURRENT USER\SOFTWARE\Michael Robinson\HugeClock

Running as a Program

Click the desktop Huge Clock icon and the program will run and show the clock. If you use Huge Clock in this normal program mode, that is not as a screensaver, your normal screensaver will kick in and appear over (and hide) Huge Clock.




Digital Signature


I purchased a <u>Code Signing</u> Certificate from <u>Certificate Authority (CA)</u> company <u>Sectigo</u> and used it to digitally sign (and timestamp) program executable file hugeclock.exe and install program hugeclock-setup.exe. The signature says it was signed by MICHAEL ROBINSON. Code Signing proves that the program actually came from me and has not been modified by a hacker since it was signed.

Run Windows File Explorer (explorer.exe) right click on the file and select Properties:




Then click on the tab Digital Signatures, and click the Details button:





Then click the View Certificate button to see my certificate:



If even one byte is changed, either in the file or in the signature, the signature will show as <u>invalid</u> in the file properties.
